



# The Department of Chemistry at the University of Central Oklahoma is hiring for two full-time faculty positions.

**POSITION 1: Assistant Professor in Inorganic, Environmental, Green Chemistry or Materials Science.** The successful candidate will teach lecture and lab courses in their field of expertise as well as general chemistry.

**POSITION 2: Assistant Professor in any area of chemistry, but with a desire to be the department NMR specialist.** The successful candidate will have extensive experience in acquiring, processing, and interpreting major one- and two-dimensional NMR experiments, be willing to instruct users in the operation of the spectrometer, and will have expertise in the routine maintenance and trouble-shooting of NMR hardware. The successful candidate will teach lecture and lab courses in his or her area of specialization, as well as an upper-division course in NMR spectroscopy.

Candidates hired in both positions will be expected to direct student-centered research projects and engage in other scholarly activities and service.

The Department of Chemistry has 15 full-time faculty and over 220 undergraduate majors in five programs.
